## **BASIC PERSONAL EQUIPMENT & UNIFORMS.**

### **COMBAT CLOTHING - ARMOURED INFANTRY.**

- Jacket M1941 - Field OD / Jacket M1943 - Field OD.
  - Shirt, Long Sleeve - Wool OD (Mustard Shade).
  - Undershirt - White T shirt / OD T shirt.
  - Trousers Wool - OD (Mustard Shade) / Trousers - Combat M1943 - OD.
  - Belt - EM, Khaki - Open face Buckle.
  - Jacket - HBT OD#7
  - Trousers - HBT OD#7
  - Cap - Garrison - Enlisted mans with blue Infantry piping.
  - Tags Identification (Dog Tags) - Notched with neck chain and extension.
  - Boots - Low Quarter, Rough out / Low Quarter, Cap toe.
  - Leggings - M1938 - Dismounted OD#3
- OR
- Boots - Combat Double Buckle.
  - Correct 2nd Armoured Division Patch on LEFT sleeve of all Jackets.

### **NOTE.**

The above minimum items will allow you to be able to fall in with a squad and participate in basic drill and squad activities.

**FIELD EQUIPMENT - ARMoured INFANTRY.**

- Helmet - Steel - M1 with liner and chin strap.
- Netting - Helmet - OD.
- Belt - Cartridge M1923, Ensure that the pouches on the belt are correct for the weapon you are carrying.
- Suspenders - Field M1936.
- Musette Bag.
- Canteen Cover - M1910.
- Canteen - M1910 / M1942.
- Cup, Canteen - M1910.
- Can - Meat, (Mess Kit).
- Issue Knife / Fork / Spoon.
- Pouch - First aid - M1910 / M1924 / M1942.
- Blanket - Wool - OD.
- Tent, Shelter - PUP with ropes and pegs. ( BOTH Halves Required).

**Optional Items.**

- Tool, Entrenching - T handle or M1943.
- Cover, Tool Entrenching M1943 or for T handle.
- Poncho - OD.
- Knife - Fighting M3 with M6 or M8 Scabbard.

**Optional Cold Weather Clothing.**

- Cap - Wool M1941 (Jeep Cap).
- Scarf - Neck Wool - OD.
- Sweater - wool - Mustard Shade.
- Gloves - Wool - OD.

**Optional Items.**

- Flash light (torch) TL 122 - A - B - C.
- Overcoat - Wool - OD (Trench Coat).
- Holster - Hip - .45 - M1916.
- Goggles - All purpose polaroid.
- Case - Map / Dispatch M1938.
- Binoculars - M3 with case.
- Mask - Gas / Assault with rubberised case.

Theses items are not mandatory. However it is hoped that over time members will acquire some or all of these items to add that bit of extra realism to their impressions.

**Class A Uniform.**

For those who wish to put together a class A uniform (Dress Uniform) you will need the following items.

- Coat - Wool Serge 4 pocket, or Jacket Field M1944 (Ike Jacket)
- Correct 2nd Armoured Patch on LEFT sleeve.
- Trousers Wool Serge - EM M1937.
- Shirt Long Sleeve - Wool - OD.
- Tie - Khaki - Cotton / Mohair.
- Cap - Garrison (Overseas Cap) with Blue Infantry Piping.
- Boots - Low Quarter, Cap Toe.

BOOTS are to be polished when worn with the class A uniform.

### **Individual Weapons.**

- U.S Rifle - Caliber .30 - M1 Garand.
- U.S Rifle - Caliber .30 - M1903a3 or M1903a4 with M73B1 Scope (Sniper).
- U.S Carbine - Caliber .30 - M1 or M1A1.
- Sub Machine Gun - M1928 - M1 / M1A1 (Thompson).
- Sub Machine Gun - M3 / M3A1 (Grease Gun).
- Pistol - Automatic - Cal .45 M1911 / M1911A1.

### **Bayonets.**

- Bayonet - M1905 - 16 inch.
- Bayonet - M1905E1 - 10 inch.
- Bayonet - M1942 - 16 inch.
- Bayonet - M1942E1 - 10 inch.
- Bayonet - M1 - 10 inch.

Due to the nature of the firearms laws here in NSW, the most common weapon we will have is the M1903 Springfield.

You can however use replicas of the other weapons listed if you have a replica permit, or even the real item if you have the appropriate license.

All members that handle weapons within Ausreenact, are all fully licensed to handle and use weapons.

**IF YOU DO NOT HOLD A CURRENT VALID FIREARMS LICENSE YOU WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO HANDLE WEAPONS.**

## DRESS AND APPEARANCE STANDARDS.

- All members of Dog company are expected to keep their uniforms and equipment in a serviceable condition.
- Members are at all times to wear their uniforms in the correct manner.
- Members are to have short hair for all public events, we do not expect a USMC high and tight. But we do expect a short tidy hair cut.
- Facial hair. - Only a mustasch will be allowed for US troops only. Sideburns are to be kept short and above the ears.
- Members are to be **CLEAN SHAVEN** at public events - A public event is an event where we are on display to the public - Example - Linwood House & Ironfest.

- Members are expected to act in a military manner when in uniform - you are representing our club and the men who wore that uniform.
